Greetings fellow owners and residents,

Summer is just around the corner and with it will be the sprinkling of lawns and warmer weather. Our sprinkler system is old and antiquated, and has failed us a few times the past few years. Our current process is to fix the problems as they occur. Please report any problems to the office if you believe your sprinklers are not working correctly. Should we have a break in one of the pipes, we need to find the break before we can fix it. Any breaks increase the likelihood of lawns turning yellow. Please be patient if this occurs. I know several residents were very unhappy last year when their lawns turned yellow.

On another note, I previously discussed the process to request information. It must be in writing and on an approved Pinebrook form which can be obtained off of Pinebrook's website, <u>pinebrookvancouver.com</u>, or from the office. Pinebrook also has a Resident Resolution form to address particular areas of concern and what actions you believe Pinebrook can take to address those concerns.

I have received some of the forms, but quite frankly, some of them were filled out in a very complex or extensive manner which will require consultation with our attorneys before Pinebrook can answer those particular requests. If your intent is to bog us down in paperwork, you're doing a good job thus far. Unfortunately that takes valuable time away from being able to work on more important matters concerning most Pinebrook residents. So if you fill out the forms, please keep them short and precise, with only one item per form.

GROUNDSKEEPING—The groundskeepers are removing debris, mowing, hard and soft edging, and trimming bushes when directed. The irrigation system is up and running.

TREE WORK — The piles of debris by the clubhouse have been removed. A new list of tree work is in progress.

ROOFING— Two homes had new roofs installed.


PAINTING — Painting on two homes was completed and two more will be completed soon.

GUTTERS — Three homes had gutter repairs completed.

RV LOT — At this time, there are 4 non-electrical and 9 electrical spaces available.

COMMON AREA— Trimming of bushes, clean-up and removal of debris is in progress. Four pathway light poles were replaced and two post lights were repaired. Bushes were trimmed and chips were installed around the clubhouse.
