Hello fellow owners and residents,

Summer is in full swing to include a couple of hot days. If the sprinkler system on your property is not working properly, please let our maintenance supervisor, Ozzie, know. We will try to keep Pinebrook's lawns green this summer.

Many of you may have celebrated the 4th of July this year. Pinebrook put out a few "no fireworks signs" before the celebration, but I received a report that most of them were taken down before the fireworks started. If you have the signs or have seen any of the signs, please return them to the Pinebrook clubhouse. You may place them up against the wall in the flower bed on the left side of the garage door just to the left of the Dropbox.

Pinebrook recently had volunteers deliver garage sale flyers to every home in Pinebrook and noticed that some of the driveways and sidewalks had a lot of moss on them and potentially represent a safety threat, especially when the moss gets wet. No one wants to get sued If someone slips on your moss and has a bad fall. Pinebrook's Vice President, Garrett Wolverton, has been keeping the moss off of his sidewalk and driveway for years and will offer an inexpensive way of getting rid of the moss in next month's newsletter. You don't necessarily have to pay for someone to pressure wash. Garrett offers a solution that does not require use of a pressure washer. Check back next month for the details on how he does it. He will have the article in its own section.

In regards to Pinebrook documents, the last time our CC&Rs were updated was April 29, 2000. It is time to update them again. The board will have several meetings over the next few months to update sections of the CC&Rs. All meetings are open to Pinebrook residents and owners. However, the plan is to have at least one meeting on the CC&Rs on the second Tuesday of each month at the clubhouse beginning at 6:30 pm. Also a committee will be looking into updating the Rules. I anticipate both updates will take a few months to implement.

RV LOT — At this time, there are 3 non-electrical and 9 electrical spaces available.


ROOF & GUTTER CLEANING — The second roof and gutter cleaning is completed.
