Greetings Pinebrook Residents and Owners,

The weather continues to improve, but better weather promotes weed growth. This topic was discussed at length during the last board meeting. It was brought up that some residents remember a time years ago when our landscape company took care of the weeding in both the lawn and the flower beds.

However, one concerned owner brought up that Pinebrook's CC&Rs did not allow Pinebrook to cover removal of weeds from the owners' flower beds. After much debate, the Pinebrook Board of Directors agreed to stop weeding people's flower beds. The Rules committee started enforcing the weeds portion of the Rules that were updated at a board meeting to take effect on January 1, 2022.

At this point in time, it is the responsibility of all residents to keep their flower bed weeds under control. Enforcement measures are still being discussed but generally speaking any lot whose weeds pose a threat to neighboring lots and lawns will most likely receive violation notices.

This is a difficult topic, but some type of action needs to take place against the exacerbation of the weed problem.

The Board of Directors is always looking for new talent. If you have any interest in serving your community, please let me know.

Maintenance Supervisor Report By Blaine (Ozzie) Ohswaldt

APRIL 2024

GROUNDSKEEPING—The groundskeepers are picking up and removing debris; mowing weekly; spring fertilizing; hard edging, and broadleaf weed spraying in common areas. The spring irrigation system evaluation is complete.

TREE WORK — A new list is being compiled

PAINTING — Several homes are scheduled for painting.

ROOFING — One home is scheduled to be replaced and one repaired.

MOSS TREATMENT—The new equipment is up and running and to-date we have treated multiple homes several times.

COMMON AREA— One post light was repaired. Clean up of the creeks and the ponds is in progress. Blue dye and chemicals were installed in the ponds to help control algae. Bids were accepted to install 1-1/2" asphalt overlay on a portion of the pathways. The return screen in the east pond was cleaned.

RV PARKING LOT — At this time, there are 6 nonelectrical and 10 electrical spaces available. Bids are being accepted for repair or replacement of the gate.

Backyards

The rules committee will start checking the backyards in May. Please take a look to make sure that extra items are not stored in the back area, especially not on your patios.

Security Cameras

We have had instances where people have been running motorized bicycles on the paths, and unauthorized people in our backyards and driveways. If you have security cameras, they can be registered with the Vancouver Police Department. By registering your camera with them, law enforcement can quickly identify near-by cameras that may have captured criminal activity in the area. You will only be contacted by a law enforcement officer if there is a criminal incident in the vicinity of your security camera. You can register your camera online by going on the Vancouver Police Department community camera registration program.

Weeds

It is the responsibility of the homeowner to control weeds on their property in the planting beds, areas between houses and any decorative planting areas created by the homeowner.
